

Who was Janus?

As you're probably aware, most of the people in the world are currently wishing each other, "Happy new year!" We, as Yahweh's people, know that Yahweh's new year actually begins in the springtime, not in the dead of winter in January. In fact, the word "January" is from the pagan two-faced Roman deity of new beginnings, named Janus, according to Ancient Roman claims. It may surprise you to learn that many of the names of the months and days of the week are from paganism.



Yahweh's calendar is much different from our modern Gregorianbased calendars. instance, in the springtime, when Yahweh's new year begins, it is known as the month of Abib. It is when the barley is ready to be harvested in Israel. Barley is not harvested in the winter time. New life and growth "springs forth" in Yahweh's new

year. Many pagan winter festivities have permeated this world, such as Christmas, New Year's, and Valentine's Day. Winter is not a good time to start a new year.

Yahweh's calendar is also different from the modern calendar in the sense that each month only has 29 or 30 days, not 31 days like some months in the Gregorian calendar. And Yahweh's new months begin with the visible sighting of the new moon (which is a thin sliver of light after sundown in the western horizon).

The reason there are so many pagan festivities in winter is due to the ancient pagans being afraid of the short frigid days when the sun sank quickly below the horizon. They would hold their festivities to the Sun deity in the hopes that the sun would return brightly in the sky. Winter was a scary time for pagans. Many either starved to death or froze to death. Praise Yahweh that we don't have to fear the seasons because He is in control of them!




