LET US KEEP THE FEAST!

By now, you may be noticing some excitement in the air with the spring Holy Days coming up! Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread are almost upon us. When we think of unleavened bread, we normally think of food that contains leavening agents that puff them up and cause them to rise. But did you know that “leaven” can also be figuratively defined as having certain bad attributes? For instance, Yahshua warned us to “Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees.” (See Luke 12:1). Specifically, the leaven of the Pharisees was hypocrisy. The Greek word, “hypocrite” actually means “actor.” So in other words, the Pharisees were acting righteous, but were not in reality.



puff up the dough. Indeed, certain attributes can cause us to be puffed up too. Pride is a particularly dangerous attitude. It is one thing to be proud of your accomplishments (which is normal and healthy) but it is not okay to allow pride to make you think you are better than other people! Scripture says that “pride goes before destruction.” (see Proverbs 16:18).

Leaven can also spread. For instance, have you ever met a really grumpy person? You may have been really happy just a few seconds before, but then you noticed yourself feeling a little grumpy just by being around him or her. That’s why it’s important to “spread” good attitudes to others! Have a very blessed spring Holy Day season!

In 1 Corinthians 5:8, we see a very interesting Scripture that reads, “Therefore Let us keep the Feast, not with the old leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.” How does leaven work? If you add it to bread dough, fermentation causes it to


