## What can we learn from the Feast of Tabernacles?

Feast of Tabernacles (also known as Sukkot or Feast of Booths) is one of the most joyful times celebrated by Yahweh's people. All of the Holy days have significance. What makes the Feast of Tabernacles extra special is that we are commanded to dwell in temporary dwellings for seven days.

In the Old Testament, the Israelites left Egypt and had no permanent place to live. They had to dwell in tents and live off the land.

So "Sukkot" helped them and us remember this event.



For the future, the Feast of Tabernacles pictures the reign of Yahshua the Messiah on this earth (the 1,000 year reign). All living will know of Yahweh's ways. 

## The Book of Esther
