ADONAI

Webster's Encyclopedic Unabridged Dictionary for Adonai: "...a substitute pronunciation of the Tetragrammaton...lit., my Lord; spoken in place of the ineffable name YAHWEH." GOD — Deity of the Nations published by The Scripture Research Association, Inc., we find a Dr. Millar Burrows who used to head the Department of Near East Languages at Yale University. In 1948 Dr. Millar was quoted as saying, "The addition of the so-called vowel points was a hoax on mankind. The substitution of the word Adonai in the place of the Tetragrammaton, Yahweh, was done because the Jews in their apostasy put to disuse the Holy Name."

Complete Jewish Bible (CJB) uses "Adonai" 7,125 times. Ultra Orthodox Bibles also use "HaShem" (Hebrew: The Name) to cover up the Name "Yahweh."

Strong's Concordance Hebrew Number 1168 Hebrew word: Ba'al {bah'-al}. Strong's shows: Baal = "lord" (Baal equals Lord).

And it shall be at that day, saith Yahweh, that thou shalt call me Husband; and shalt call me no more Baali. For I will take away the names of the Baals out of her mouth, and they shall no more be remembered by their name, Hosea 2:16-17

Wesley's Commentary: "Baali — that is, my Lord...by their name — their names perishing with them."

Which think to cause My people to forget My Name by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten My Name for Baal, Jeremiah 23:27.

Strong's Concordance says: Lord or Baal was the "supreme male divinity of the Phoenicians or Canaanites."

Easton's Bible Dictionary Beelzebub — (Gr. form *Beel'zebul*), the name given to Satan, and found only in the New Testament (Matt. 10:25; 12:24, 27; Mark 3:22). It is probably the same as Baalzebub (q.v.), the god of Ekron, meaning "the lord of flies," or, as others think, "the lord of dung," or "the dung-god."

Encyclopedia Britannica, 11th edition: "God — The common Teutonic word for a personal object of religious worship...<u>applied to all those superhuman beings of the heathen mythologies</u>. The word 'god' on the conversion of the Teutonic peoples were converted to Christianity was <u>adopted as the same name of the one Supreme Being...</u>"

Encyclopedia of Religion and Ethics, vol. 6, page 302 "...after the conversion of Teutons to Christianity the word [God] came to be applied to the Christian Deity..."

Merriam Webster Dictionary: Teu•ton \'tü-t[∂]n, 'tyü-\ noun

- 1: a member of an ancient probably Germanic or Celtic people
- 2 : a member of a people speaking a language of the Germanic branch of the Indo-European language family; *especially* : GERMAN.

Please note: The pagan origins of the name "God" go back even further! Genesis 30:9-11, Zilpah, Leah's maid, produced a child for Jacob and named him "GD" (Hebrew letters: *gimel dalet*).

The Scriptures: But you are those who forsake [YAHWEH (written in Hebrew)], who forget My set-apart mountain, who prepare a table for Gad, and who fill a drink offering for Meni, Isaiah 65:11.

Come Out of Her My People, by C.J. Koster: "All commentators agree that Gad [pronounced gawd, see Strong's #1409] is a pagan deity, and so is Meni. Gad is usually interpreted as the well-known Syrian or Canaanite deity of 'Good Luck' or 'Fortune,' and Meni the deity of 'Destiny.' This Gad is written in the Hebrew as GD, but the Massoretes afterwards vowel-pointed it, adding an 'a,' to give us 'Gad.' However, we find other references in Scripture to a similar deity, if not the same one, also spelt GD in the Hebrew text but this time vowel-pointed to read 'Gawd' or 'God' (Jos. 11:17, 12:7, 13:5), where we find 'Baal-Gawd'...according to the vowel-pointing Massoretic Hebrew text. This Baal-Gawd...was obviously a place named after their deity." Baal-God or Lord-God, either way, it's pagan in origin.

What did Yahweh tell Moses to tell the people? Elohim, furthermore, said to Moses, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'Yahweh, the Elohim of your fathers, the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob, has sent me to you.' This is My Name forever, and this is My Memorial-Name to all generations," Exodus 3:15 NASB. What are we to tell the people?
