

FEAST of TABERNACLES 2026



Dear Brethren and Co-Workers,

Yahweh's Assembly in Yahshua will be keeping the Feast of Tabernacles here at our Kingdom City assembly building located at 2963 County Road 233, Kingdom City, MO. We do not offer housing, but feel free to bring tents for camping, or RV's, motor homes, etc. There are also local hotels/motels located three miles from our site. We have a very limited number of RV spots. We offer electric hookups, but no water or sewer. Bathrooms with showers are available in the main building, along with a full kitchen with stoves and refrigerators.

Dress appropriately, as Missouri's sometimes cool Autumn days and nights demand warm clothing. But these days can also be warm and sometimes rainy. Prepare for any kind of weather. Also, both men and women should dress modestly. Ladies should wear a head covering (scarf or hat) during services, prayer, and Bible studies, while men should not have their heads covered during those times. Please let us know if you have a pet, and we will try to accommodate you.

NEITHER TOBACCO USE NOR DRINKING ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY.

Just a reminder, we are extremely busy before the Feast. Those flying to St. Louis should check on the availability of the Greyhound bus line (Toll Free 1-800-231-2222), which makes a stop at the St. Louis terminal. If you give us enough notice, we may be able to arrange for someone to come and pick you up. MOX (pronounced: mow-ex) is the shuttle service and they do drop-offs and pick-ups at Kingdom City, MO., for the St. Louis airport. Their toll-free number is 877-669-4826.

The first meeting will be at 7:00 pm Saturday evening (September 26th), which begins the High Sabbath of the Feast of Tabernacles. We will be having regular Sabbath services on September 26th at 1:30 pm. The high day date and time are, of course, contingent on the sighting of the Trumpets' new moon on the evening of September 12th.

To help us plan for a smooth-running Feast, please complete the enclosed reservation form and return to us by September 1st.

If you have never attended a Feast of Tabernacles, make this, your year of obedience. Prove Yahweh now herewith and see whether He won't pour out His blessings. We of Yahweh's Assembly in Yahshua try to keep Tabernacles much as did ancient Israel. We gather in temporary dwellings such as campers and tents where we can be fairly close together.
