It will be a good investment of the materials and my work."




I have a suggestion for a project that, if you will build it, will last a lot longer than that brick BBQ. That project is found and explained in:

1 Corinthians 13:1-10 GNB *I may be able to speak the languages of human beings and even of angels, but if I have no love, my speech is no more than a noisy gong or a clanging bell. I may have the gift of inspired preaching; I may have all knowledge and understand all secrets; I may have all the faith needed to move mountains — but if I have no love, I am nothing. I may give away everything I have, and even give up my body to be burned — but if I have no love, this does me no good. Love is patient and kind; it is not jealous or conceited or proud; love is not ill-mannered or selfish or irritable; love does not keep a record of wrongs; love is not happy with evil but is happy with the truth. Love can patiently endure anything and its faith, hope, and patience never fail. Love never fails. There are inspired messages, but they are temporary; there are gifts of speaking in other languages, but they will cease; there is knowledge, but it will pass. For our gifts of knowledge and of inspired messages are only partial; but when what is perfect comes, then what is partial will be rendered useless.*

The time Paul is writing about is the time after Yahshua's return! In the kingdom, we will be changed into eternal spirit beings. Then we will truly have all these things as part of ourselves. We will have complete knowledge and will all speak in the eternal language.

1 Corinthians 13:11-13 GNB *When I was a child, my speech, feelings, and thinking were all those of a child; now that I am an adult, I have no more use for childish ways. What we see now is like a dim image in a mirror; then we shall see face-to-face. What I know now is only partial; then it will be com-*

One of those — love — is the greatest, most important, most useful for helping people today and in the 1000 year kingdom and for working together forever.



Possibly our best investment in all our lives is to learn to be a very loving person. Paul described it pretty well — patient, kind, humble, generous, polite, steady, having a good positive attitude, valuing truth, faith, and hope. Yahshua said we need to love one another like He has loved us.

Whatever we do on this project will make our life much better AND it will last forever — not merely a few hundred years — but FOREVER. Yahweh will help you in this project and if you get it right Yahweh will love it.

So let us build pure love into our character. It's a good investment that will pay dividends now and be very useful forever.

Needs Repeating, 155 Years Later!

Whereas the Senate of the United States, devoutly recognizing the supreme authority and just government of Almighty [Elohim] in all the affairs of men and of nations, has by a resolution requested the President to designate and set apart a day for national prayer and humiliation; and

Whereas it is the duty of nations as well as of men to own their dependence upon the overruling power of [Elohim], to confess their sins and transgressions in humble sorrow, yet with assured hope that genuine repentance will lead to mercy and pardon, and to recognize the sublime truth, announced in the Holy Scriptures and proven by all history, that those nations only are blessed whose [Elohim] is [Yahweh];

And, insomuch as we know that by His divine law nations, like individuals, are subjected to punishments and chastisements in this world, may we not justly fear that the awful calamity of civil war which now desolates the land may be but a punishment inflicted upon us for our presumptuous sins, to the needful end of our national reformation as a whole people? We have been the recipients of the choicest bounties of Heaven; we have been preserved these many years in peace and prosperity; we have grown in numbers, wealth, and power as no other nation has ever grown. But we have forgotten [Elohim]. We have forgotten the gracious hand which preserved us in peace and multiplied and enriched and strengthened us, and we have vainly imagined, in the deceitfulness of our hearts, that all these blessings were produced by some superior wisdom and virtue of our own. Intoxicated with unbroken success, we have become too self-sufficient to feel the necessity of redeeming and preserving grace, too proud to pray to the [Elohim] that made us.

It behooves us, then, to humble ourselves before the offended Power, to confess our national sins, and to pray for clemency and forgiveness.

Now, therefore, in compliance with the request, and fully concurring in the views of the Senate, I do by this my proclamation designate and set apart Thursday, the 30th day of April, 1863, as a day of national humiliation, fasting, and prayer. And I do hereby request all the people to abstain on that day from their ordi-



nary secular pursuits, and to unite at their several places of public worship and their respective homes in keeping the day holy to [Yahweh] and devoted to the humble discharge of the religious duties proper to that solemn occasion.

All this being done in sincerity and truth, let us then rest humbly in the hope authorized by the divine teachings that the united cry of the nation will be heard on high and answered with blessings no less than the pardon of our national sins and the restoration of our now divided and suffering country to its former happy condition of unity and peace. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the United States to be affixed.

Done at the city of Washington, this 30th day of March, A. D. 1863, and of the Independence of the United States the eighty-seventh.



Passover Memorial Service Information

With this year’s confirmation of early barley and the new moon on the evening of March 18th, we will be planning for the **Passover Memorial Service after sunset on March 31st. At 7:30pm**, after the weekly Sabbath, we will look forward to those who are baptized in Yahshua’s Name, to join with us for this very important time. Only those baptized in the Saving Name of Yahshua are allowed to partake of the foot washing, emblems of grape juice and unleavened bread (symbolic of His blood and body).

For brethren not able to be with us, we have provided an outline paper (available online or via postal mail) which will help guide one through this time period, just after sunset, on the 14th Biblical day. This is when
