Paranoia + Phobia = Panic

Upon the onslaught of Hitler's 'blitzkreig' bombing raids of London and other British cities during the early years of World War II, Prime Minister Winston Churchill, perhaps the greatest statesman of the 20th century, sought to encourage his constituencies to "Be Calm, And Carry On," rivaled only by President Franklin Delano Roosevelt's observation during the same time period, that "The Only Thing We Have To Fear Is Fear Itself."

And now, "Be Calm, And Carry On ... The Only Thing We Have To Fear Is Fear Itself" seems to be fitting exhortations to those given over to the hysteria and pandemonium that has attended COVID-19. Indeed, perhaps for many, this time may represent 'the beginning of sorrows' (Matt. 24:8) and as the disease further impacts global economic



and health delivery infrastructures, a precursory fulfillment of the prophetic, "Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth" (Luke 21:26).

For shortages on grocery shelves of staples such as toilet

paper, sanitizers, baby wipes, paper towels, potatoes, dairy and poultry products, lunch meats, canned goods, sugar, flour, bottled water, bread, etc., etc., have made people, unaccustomed to the hardships of the Great Depression of 90 years ago and to the rationing of consumable and durable products during World War II, fearful of doing and going without.


Indeed, to the uninitiated in faith, this is a day of trouble and perplexity (Isa. 22:5). But know this: It is become much more – a day of rebuke, for the mass of humanity who would not like to have the knowledge of Yahweh (Rom. 1:28), neither receive to themselves the love of the Truth that they might be saved (2 Thess. 2:10).

No, instead, they entertained their days of blasphemy (Isa. 37:3) and have consequently, been given over to, and were sent of Him, a reprobate mind (Rom. 1:28). It was His choosing of their delusions (Isa. 66:4) to do such things not convenient to their salvation, and by which they should be judged and condemned (2 Thess. 2:11-12).

Paranoia + Phobia = Panic ...,cont.

The believer, however, is reminded in 'this perilous time' (2 Tim. 3:1) – when all the world is leaning to its own understanding (Prov. 3:5), walking by sight (2 Cor. 5:7) ... for not all men will have faith (2 Thess. 3:2) – that Yahweh has not given them, the spirit of fear but a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7). And, moreover, He will not suffer the soul of the righteous to famish (Prov. 10:3); neither be forsaken; nor found begging bread (Psa. 39: 25).

So, what should the disposition of the believer be in this time?

- First, to trust that Yahweh will direct his steps, through acknowledging Him in all his ways (Prov. 3:5-6);
- Second, to watch and pray that he might be counted worthy to escape all these things spoken prophetically, that shall come upon the earth (Luke 21:36);
- Third, to regard that for such a time as this, he has come to the Kingdom (Est. 4:14).

Yes, to this end has every believer been born, and for this cause has He came into the world (John 18:37): that though we should suffer trials, Yahweh is faithful, that with the trial, to make a way of escape (1 Cor. 10:13), that we may be able to bear it; that we may also reign with Yahshua (2 Tim. 2:12).

Five Criteria

- 3. When experiencing infirmity, necessity, or distress, one is to worship Yahweh instead of blaming Him.
- 4. Discharging whole duty and reasonable service by fearing Yahweh, keeping His commandments, and working righteousness.
- 5. Giving Him no rest 'til He establish.

Little wonder, so few ever attain to that position: Becoming "A Man After Yah's Own Heart!" Few ever get to repentance, immediate or otherwise and fewer still, to facing their sin; and if they do, they stumble over spirit and truth worship; and complain rather, "Where Is He?" when adversity comes; and of duty and service? What commandment? And what's righteousness? And of rest? They're tired now, and besides, they're already established ... uh, that is, dead in trespasses and sins.

How good it should be, if all who are zealously affected in good things would purpose this day, and not defer the doing of it to "a convenient season" but would instead, Just Do It.


