
Conversion: Null and Void!

When does conversion become null and void? The short answer is when one forsakes Yahweh. The long answer takes some contemplation.

"Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils ... and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him ... for he was numbered among us, and had obtained part of this ministry" (Matt. 10:8, 4; Acts 1:17).

And so, the question comes, what if a member of the presbytery – elder or deacon,

- thought established and settled in the faith (1 Pet. 5:10);
- having himself tasted of the Heavenly Gift and been made a partaker of the Holy Spirit and the powers of the world to come (Heb. 6:4-5);
- and to whose trust a dispensation of the Evangel had been committed (1 Cor. 9:17);
- whose speech and preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power (1 Cor. 2:4) should fall away.



Does his last estate – "when the righteous turns away from his righteousness, and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked man does" (Ezek. 18:24) – nullify the authenticity of his previously good works and affect the grace with which the recipients of his ministry had received of Yahweh?

And the answer? The Apostle Paul, in his farewell address to the believers at Ephesus among whom he had labored for three years and from whom he kept back nothing that was profitable to them, neither shunned to declare the whole counsel of the heavenly Father, foretold them there should arise among them, men with smooth and feigned, fair speeches

and great swelling words of vanity, speaking perverse things by which they would draw away disciples after themselves (Acts 20:31, 20, 27, 30).

And so, thus we judge – as well, the Scripture – that if the recipient of the defector's previously good ministry should, with him, turn away from the

Truth (Titus 1:14), he will afterward, with him, made his every good work reprobate (Titus 1:16), seeing he no longer has before Yahweh the answer of a good conscience void of offense (Acts 24:16; 1 Pet. 3:21).

But so long as he renounces the hidden things of dishonesty (2 Cor. 4:2); continues steadfastly in (Acts 2:42), and earnestly contends for the faith (Jude 1:3); then he has not forsaken the hope of his salvation. Through giving diligence to working out his salvation (Phil. 2:12), both willing and doing Yahweh's good pleasure (Phil. 2:13), such a person retains his right standing with Him Who has called him to sanctification (1 Thess. 4:3) and bears nothing of the reproach the other has brought upon himself.

Indeed, will men who behold his good works and are given reason to glorify His Father Which is in Heaven (Matt. 5:16), rather regard him who stands against the current of the defector's hypocrisy.

Whether a short or long answer, the same end is for those whom repentance is no longer found. But for those who repent and overcome, hope in the Master.
