Three Presumptions & Conclusions

Presumption #1: The bricks are fallen down, but we will build with hewn stones: the sycamores are cut down, but we will change [them into] cedars, Isaiah 9:10.

Following the terrorists' attacks that made rubble of the twin towers of Manhattan's World Trade Center and took the lives of more than 3,000 persons, politicians and their pulpit colleagues **presumed** to appropriate *these*



hallowed words to support their resolve to rebuild a monument that would represent the resilience of America to rise to any challenge to maintain its superiority and supremacy – as the head, among nation-tails.

They which have, amongst the cheers of their audiences, rhetorically pronounced *these words* subsequent to the occurrences on September 11, 2001, have done so without appreciating *their context* ... that *these words* convey a people's "pride and stoutness of heart" (Isa. 9:9) and were become pre-

cisely the reason Yahweh here is foretelling that He would set up adversaries, to "cut off from Israel head and tail, branch and rush, in one day" (Isa. 9:14) as a just recompense for their recalcitrant disposition that set them at variance with Yahweh's summoning them to repentance and that *they* are just as well, applicable to this nation called the United States of America.

Presumptions 2: And the priest shall [take] some of the blood of the trespass offering, and the priest shall put [it] upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be cleansed, and upon the thumb of his right hand and upon the great toe of his right foot, Leviticus 14:14.

"... of him that is to be cleansed ..." (Lev. 14:14) – identified here, as one who was come before the priest ... here functioning in his office as a public health officer, with authority either to declare one afflicted with leprosy healed of his infirmity, and now having his right restored to hear the word of Yahweh; to partake of the commonwealth of the people; to touch anything without defiling it; and to go into any house or company where he thought fit; or, if he should be determined as yet unfit, to have the period of his quarantine extended. The application of the blood to these body parts – the right ear, the right thumb, the right great toe – signified his cleansing from, and atonement for, his sins that were past and that henceforth, these parts were to be

exercised herewith, for purposes that are good to the use of edifying.

By inference, some have **presumed** the injury sustained by presidential candidate Donald Trump in Pennsylvania on July 13, 2024, from an assassin's bullet to his right ear and of him, subsequently, touching with his right hand, the blood issuing from the site of his injured ear, constitutes Yahweh's application of the victim's own blood as a cleansing-atonement for his past sins, implying, of course, that "without shedding of blood is no remission" (Heb. 9:22) ... though the writer of "these words," doubtlessly had the shedding of Yahshua's blood in mind toward sprinkling one's conscience that afterward, he should walk soberly and righteously.




Lastly, on this point that leprosy was purely a bodily disease, anciently the affliction was understood as a manifestation of its victim having yielded to spreading slander – *lashon hara*, evil speech – and that its exhibition of physical malaise was intended to bring the malefactor to repentance.

Presumption # 3: Then shalt thou kill the ram, and take of his blood, and put [it] upon the tip of the right ear of Aaron, and upon the tip of the right ear of his sons, and upon the thumb of their right hand and upon the great toe of their right foot, and sprinkle the blood upon the altar round about, Exodus 29:20.

Some have **presumed** the failed assassination attempt on the life of candidate Donald Trump on the 13th of July of this year, leaving him with a bloody issue from his right ear which he touched with his right hand and perhaps, either dripped upon, or was touched by, his right foot, are but Yahweh's approbation of becoming the next President. Perhaps. After all, *Eloha is the Judge: He putteth down one, and setteth up another*, **Psalm 75:7.** And, certainly, none can deny Him His providence from Whom all authority proceeds, *to do so – to put down one, and set up another –* whether he (or she) who occupies the seat of power is righteous, "the throne is established by Righteousness" (Prov. 16:12) or occupied by rulers who by agenda, policy, and practice, are spiritually reprobate.

But Mr. Trump narrowly surviving a mortal attempt upon his life with but a slight injury with evidence of blood to his right ear, and upon the phalanges of his right hand and stockinged right foot, could hardly be considered a parallel to that order of consecration by which Yahweh ordained His priests, Aaron and his sons and their successors, in the performance of their service to Him and in behalf of His people.

Indeed, might it instead be argued, that Mr. Trump is a man of like passions with every other member of his species, and has at least, as great a need for redemption, salvation, and deliverance in Yahshua's Name, as any other and that to make anything more of a shooting in Pennsylvania on the 13th of this month – a bullet that drew blood from his right ear, just missing its victim's cranium by centimeters – will only but serve to elevate Mr. Trump to a sacrosanct position that neither he, nor any other, can neither **presume** to himself and
