


KIDS FOR YAH


meantime, Peter's friends had joined in homes to petition Yahweh on Peter's behalf.



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FATHER

The Hebrew word for “Father” is “Ab.” It sounds like “Ah-b.”



In Ancient Hebrew the letter “A” looks like: (a head of an ox). It stands for the words: Strength, Power, Chief.



The Ancient Hebrew letter “B” looks like: (a floor plan of a house or tent). It stands for the words: House, Within, Family.

To make the word “Father,” the two letters are written together



like this: . In Hebrew, words are read from right to left – just opposite of English words.

So, who is the Chief of the House? Who is the Strength of the Family? FATHER!

Almost all Hebrew words are made with letters that are arranged in such a manner as to explain or define each word!
