In the first years as the king of Israel, Saul was a very good leader. He was careful always to obey Yahweh's laws. Saul led his army to fight against soldiers from other countries, and Yahweh gave him victory after victory. But gradually King Saul began to forget that his power came from Yahweh.

Then Saul's army captured a town with many fine sheep and cattle. Yahweh commanded that everything, even these animals, be destroyed. Saul decided instead, to send the sheep and cows home with his men. The prophet Samuel grew very angry. He gravely told Saul, "Since you have turned away from Yahweh, He now turns away from you" (1 Sam. 15:23).

Jesse had one more son who was out caring for the sheep. When Samuel saw David, Yahweh told him this young man would be the next king of Israel. The slingshot was a patch of leather or cloth that had two braided cords on each end.

David had a very colorful life. He was not perfect, but he was obedient to Yahweh. He was also a skilled warrior and a poet. And He was a man after Yahweh's own heart.



