

David, son of Jesse

David was a very special man. He was the youngest son of a man named Jesse. As a shepherd, it was David's job to protect his father's sheep from attacks by wolves. He most likely used a slingshot to do this. The slingshot was a patch of leather or cloth that had two braided cords on each end. The shepherd would place a smooth pebble in the patch and twirl the slingshot around his head. When he let go of one of the cords, the pebble would fly through the air like a deadly bullet. David probably developed a strong arm and a good eye using his slingshot to defend his father's animals. This skill would later come in handy.

Jesse's three older sons were old enough to fight the Philistines in King Saul's army. Like any father, he worried about his sons. So he packed some

food and asked David to deliver it to his brothers. The young shepherd, David, traveled to the battlefield. This was the first time he saw the giant Philistine warrior Goliath, the champion of the Philistines. For forty days, Goliath had been taunting the Israelite soldiers. David was just a youth, but his faith in Yahweh was very strong. David, tired of Goliath's taunting, boldly declared, "How dare Goliath speak against the army of Yahweh? He is no different than the vicious animals I kill which attack my father's sheep. I will fight him and Yahweh will give me victory" (1 Sam. 17:26, 34-36).

So King Saul allowed David to confront Goliath. Goliath was insulted that a child would come to fight him. He arrogantly laughed. But his laughter quickly faded as David killed him

with his small slingshot! Goliath fell dead, facedown. Giants are no match for Yahweh. He is with His people and gives them victory over their enemies.






