


Yahweh's Plan of Salvation in the Holy Days

Did you know that all of Yahweh's Holy Days have significant meaning and tells us His exciting plan of salvation for all mankind? Lets see what the feasts mean!

- 1. Passover is first. It is known as *Pesach* in Hebrew. It signifies repentance and acceptance of Yahshua Messiah's sacrifice for our sins; reconfirming our commitment. It is not a High Day.
- 2. Feast of Unleavened Bread signifies cleaning of leaven (which can represent sin) from our lives. We are also reminded of Yahweh's help of Israel times past.
- 3. Pentecost (*Shavuot* in Hebrew) was when Yahweh's Spirit was given to remain on earth to help us in our walk with Yahshua to properly keep the law.
- 4. Feast of Trumpets (*Yom Teruah* in Hebrew) is usually looked at as The Day of Yahweh, and most likely ushering in the return of Yahshua to raise up a Kingdom of priests.
- 5. The Day of Atonement, known as *Yom Kippur* in Hebrew, signifies the blood covering of all who are washed in the blood of the lamb (Yahshua). It also shows us the banishment of Satan and us becoming at one with Father Yahweh.
- 6. Feast of Tabernacles (*Sukkot*) shows us the reign of Yahshua on earth for a thousand years. All people will be living Yahweh's way.
- 7. The Eighth Day signifies time out of time. A time of new beginnings. It will be an exciting time when many will have their first opportunity to fully understand Yahweh's truth and to accept or deny it.


